Dr. Eric B. Litwack is a professional ethicist and philosopher with experience in both Canada and the UK. He has been an EthicScan Associate since 2003, concentrating on the development of general ethical reasoning skills, corporate social responsibility and content-writing for organisational audits. He is currently an Associate Professor of Philosophy at Queen's University's Bader International Study Centre (BISC). Eric is also a regular member of the faculty of the Syracuse University School of Architecture's London Program, where he teaches philosophy of technology.

He has produced numerous articles and public talks on a wide range of philosophical topics, and he is the author of a book on the philosophy of value. From 2000—2002, he was a consultant to the British government on a project developing ethical and professional standards in Ukraine. A bilingual Montrealer by background, Eric presents to groups in both English and French. He has been active in human rights and democracy advocacy in both Canada and the UK, and he has developed a number of adult education programs in both of these countries.

In his consulting work, Eric attempts to combine trouble-shooting approaches to strategy with general logical and ethical reasoning skills. He works at combining his work on theory with attention to particular cases confronted in real work situations. Based now in the English countryside, he has developed a keen sense of intercultural and inter-organisational dialogue in both North American and European contexts.
